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### Sushi for Old City

Ken Sze, 31, grew up in the restaurant business, as his parents owned Yokohama in Maple Shade, which won a solid reputation thanks to his uncle, a master sushi chef. After studies at Drexel University, he went into finance — until, as he says, “I fell back in.” He learned the trade, especially fish selection.

Settling in Philadelphia, like many suburban-raised millennials, Sze said he found the sushi scene lacking. In April, he hopes to open **Tuna Bar** in the new apartment building at Second and Race Streets in Old City.

Sze says the look, by Boxwood Design, will be “simple but modern, upscale, and relaxed,” with a look that is not “super-Japanese. I’m all-American.”
